In comparison to driving on the level, when driving down hill: It is more difficult for the engine to hold the car back. Your brakes will take longer to slow the vehicle. You must brake sooner to stop the car. Pressing the clutch down will cause the car to gather speed. Releasing the accelerator will cause your car to slow less.

In the case of a popular car model with ABS, equipped with winter tyres, you need 33 meters to stop from the speed of 50 km/h on a flat, snow-covered stretch of road. The same car needs a few more meters (37 meters) when going downhill on a slope of 4%. The situation becomes even worse when the car is fitted with summer tyres.

## **Winter driving tips: moving off uphill and downhill ...**

Moving off and stopping downhill. For moving off we use a routine called P O M P = preparation; O = observation; M = manoeuvre; Moving off downhill.
